

The Point Spread

The following point system is in effect for articles and photos submitted for publication in the DZ.

SUBMISSION POINTS

Articles over 500 words	25 points
Articles under 500 words	15 points
Original Tech Tips	15 points
Regular Columns (Pres/Editor)	15 points
Original photos (run in DZ)	10 points
Letter to the Editor(s)	10 points
Post-Event Follow-up Articles	10 points
Reprints of Photos / Articles	5 points

RULES

- Accumulate 100 points and you will receive a “gift certificate” entitling you to one free dinner at a Chapter-sponsored dinner meeting. Any number can play, any number can win!
- Editors have final authority on what is published...only appropriate articles will be printed.
- Points will be awarded to any article or photo printed in the DZ.
- Word count is determined by common editorial practice, i.e. not counting small word)s such as “a,” “an,” “the,” etc. Generally, the size of the article is figured as: 8 words per column line on a two column page.
- Points will be discarded after three-years.
